ARTISTS' CO-OP GALLERY

Gallery Membership Requirements and Information

✓	We are a cooperative gallery established in 1980 as a group of local artists, whose purpose is the displaying and selling of fine arts.
✓	Each artist has artwork display in an equally enhancing space, as well as enjoying the benefit of hanging their 2-D art in several prominent outside businesses.
✓	As a group, we participate in outside events for the purpose of Gallery exposure and to be part of the community. Member special events and charity events may be scheduled during extended hours.
✓	Dues are \$150 per quarter and are payable on the first of the month. We ask you to give us a six month commitment. The Gallery collects and submits the sales tax and charges 20% commission on the sales of which 15% goes to the building owners and 5% into Gallery.
✓	Members <u>are required to attend each monthly meeting</u> currently being held on the first Tuesday of the month. Gallery hours are currently Wednesday – Saturday (A shift is 10 am to 2:30 pm and B shift is from 2:30 pm to 7pm) and Sunday shift is 12 pm to 5 pm. The Gallery is closed Monday and Tuesdays.
✓	As this is a co-op, our artists staff the Gallery and perform Gallery duties. Each artist works at least 2 shifts (4.5 hours per shift – Sundays are 5 hours) and possible more based upon membership.
✓	We regularly rotate the art, paint and do general clean-up and you will be expected to participate.
✓	You are eligible to join the Gallery if you are a Washington State Artist and are over the age of 18.

✓ The following items <u>are not</u> accepted: ceramics cast form, works made from kits or mass produced parts, crocheting, knitting, string art, candles, decoupage or shell craft.
